Impact of Your Gift

Lesley Ellis School has five areas of fundraising: Lesley Ellis Annual Fund, "Heading Home" Capital Campaign, Jon Pfeifer Memorial Funds, Spring Fundraiser/Party and Parents' Association. All of these areas have separate fundraising goals, as well as distinct areas that they support. Below is a snapshot of the impact your LEAF gift can have on our students and faculty.

6 gifts of \$65 (\$390)

pays for one faculty and one administrator to attend a workshop with the Association of Independent Schools in New England. The information gathered at a workshop is brought back to LES to help with curriculum planning, programming and institutional benchmarking.

100 gifts of \$58 (\$5,800)

supplies *Go Math* books for the 77 students in grades 1 thru 6.



10 gifts of \$239 (\$2,390) pays for 2 new air conditioning units for classrooms this year.

The Lesley Ellis Annual Fund allows for a diverse student body with 25% of Lesley Ellis families receiving financial assistance.



1 gift of \$680 will close the gap between the average cost of tuition and the actual cost of educating one Lesley Ellis student.

1 gift of \$140 will pay for Sound Cloud to house the LES audio archive for the music program.

2 gifts of \$471 (\$942)

will purchase 2 student desks and 4 student chairs for our growing Middle School.

8 gifts of \$235 (\$1,880) will pay for all faculty and staff to receive CPR and First Aid training, annually.

100% participation in the Lesley Ellis Annual Fund strengthens our community!

2 gifts of \$167 (\$335) will send two early childhood faculty to the Massachusetts Association of Educators of Young Children conference to network with colleagues from across the state, learn about current trends in research and development, as well as different educational philosophies and approaches used in other institutions. This knowledge is then disseminated to fellow LES faculty and integrated into the day-to-day classroom activities.



25 gifts of \$26.60 (\$665) will purchase *Handwriting Without Tears* books for all 48 students in Kindergarten thru grade 2.
