Say & Spray...

All you need is a spray bottle and chalk. Write random letters spread apart on the sidewalk or driveway. One person says a letter the other person sprays the letter. You can also use numbers and shapes.

GET CREATIVE

Easy Cloud Dough...

Ingredients:

- Hair conditioner
- Cornstarch
- A bowl
- A spatula
- Food coloring optional

Put equal amounts of conditioner and cornstarch in a bowl, mix together. Start with smaller amounts of ingredients until you find the right amounts. Different conditioners have various amounts of water and will affect the ratio. Keep mixing until it is the right consistency. You might have to mix it by hand too. Add coloring to finished dough by making a ball, poking a hole with your finger and adding a drop coloring in the hole. Close hole and massage.



Help make dinner or dessert by helping to mix ingredients. Maybe even help pour some of the ingredients.
