What do students need to bring to their chats:

- Orange writing folders
- Blank prompts (print pdf we sent or any lined paper)
- Ten frame worksheet and ten frame attachment to daily email
- Break Journals

Literacy: Writer's Workshop: In the classroom, we have a number of established routines for this time, and the students know them well. It is a quiet work time, and the students work on any project that they choose. Pencils are used for all writing, and students can use anything at your disposal for illustration. There are 3 choices during Writer's Workshop: "When you're done, you've just begun!"

- Add words
- Add to illustrations
- Start a new project

What we would like to ask parents is to consider having a timer on for about 20 minutes, and redirecting your k students back to their task if they say that they are finished. In the classroom we also give feedback for all the skills that the students show, and try to challenge students to write more, to add details, or to re-read their work as they write.
