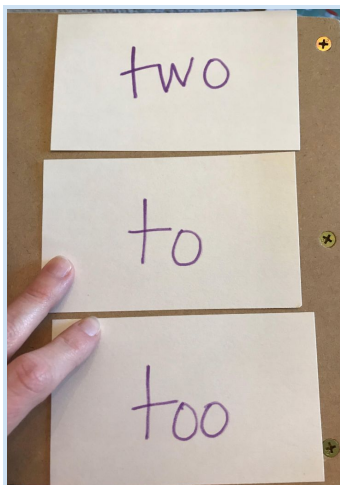

### Today's Challenge: Water Bottle Bowling



#### Instructions:

Locate 6 to 10 water bottles to use for water bottle bowling. Fill the pins partway with water and then replace the caps. Set up the pins and use any ball around the house that you can hold in one hand to try to knock them over. Water bottle bowling can be played both indoors and outdoors. If you find the game to be too easy, try stepping back further for an added challenge.
