GET CREATIVE

Easy Macrame...

Materials:

- 8 equal lengths string
- 1/2 scooped out orange peel
- bird food or grass seed

Tie all 8 strings together about one inch in. Section the strings into pairs. Tie each pair in a knot 1 inch from the last knot. Divide the string into new pairs and tie each pair 1 inch from the last knot. Slip the scooped orange into the cradle you made. Pull all the strings straight up and tie all 8 strings together at the top of the string. Fill with seeds. Hang outside and wait for the birds to arrive! If you need help look <u>here.</u>
